Daily Notes for the week of December 17-20, 2018:

Unit Focus: We Are Family

Weekly Learning Goal:

1. To participate in a variety of activities celebrating winter holidays.

Books: How the Grinch Stole Christmas by Dr. Seuss

The Polar Express by Chris Van Allsburg

Songs: Jingle Bells, Feliz Navidad

Each day this week, children will participate in a school-wide holiday activity during the large group time. Afterward, children will return to their classroom to participate in small group centers and snack.

Ms. Emilie's Room: Day 1- In learning centers, children will participate in a cooking project by following a recipe to make latkes (potato pancakes) and enjoy shaving cream in the sensory table.

Day 2: In learning centers, children will make Christmas trees out of play dough, then decorate them with electrical lights from the unit on circuits. Children will also create a journal entry describing how they made their lights work.

Ms. Jessica's Room (math): Day 1: In learning centers, children will follow a recipe to bake sugar cookies and dramatic play a holiday scene using artificial snow and small family toys.

Day 2: In learning centers, children will continue to dramatic play a holiday scene using artificial snow and small family toys. Children will also create a journal entry describing how they would enjoy time in the snow.



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
