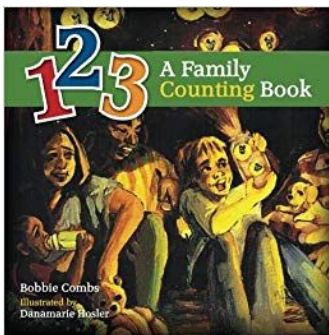

### Weekly Learning Goals
